



CAMP WRIGHTWOOD RULZZZ ...

1. **CHECK-IN IS 4:00 P.M. - 6:00 P.M. ON YOUR SCHEDULED ARRIVAL DATE.** You must NOT arrive earlier than 4:00 p.m. unless prior, special arrangements are made with Camp Management. The Group Leader and First Aid Person should be the first to arrive, and should check-in at the Camp Office to receive final lodging assignments and any special information.
2. THE USER GROUP'S CAMPERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THEIR OWN BEDDING, TOILETRIES, AND OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS.
3. *Please discourage your participants from bringing large amounts of cash, or very expensive items—the Camp Insurance does not cover loss of such.*
4. The Camp provides one bundle (about 9 logs) of firewood at each fireplace and at the fire ring for each night of your stay. **Additional bundles are available for purchase at the local gas station, hardware and grocery stores.**
5. **PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED** in Camp Wrightwood. 
6. Linens are provided for the Huddle Hut and Retreat Cabin only.
7. Camp Wrightwood does not provide health services.
8. ALL USER GROUPS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING 1) FIRST AID SUPPLIES, 2) A PERSON CURRENTLY CERTIFIED IN AT LEAST RED CROSS STANDARD FIRST AID, AND 3) FOR PROVIDING THEIR OWN EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION. All guests are covered under the site's accident insurance policy, details of which are available from the Camp Office or the BCORM Office.
9. Damaged or missing camp property will be charged to the User Group.
10. **NOISE CURFEW: 10 P.M..** San Bernardino County has placed a Noise Curfew upon Camp Wrightwood; therefore, the Camp Manager reserves the right to regulate the use of music and sound equipment.
11. Self-Cooking User Groups are responsible for bringing dishwashing supplies in addition to food supplies.
12. The Camp Manager reserves the right to designate the facilities available to the group.
13. The **CAMP TELEPHONE IS FOR EMERGENCY USE ONLY.**
14. *Most cellular services now work in the lower elevations of Camp Wrightwood.*
15. **HUDDLE HUT & RETREAT CABIN:** There is no minimum guarantee, nor children's discount for the Huddle Hut nor the Retreat Cabin because they are rented on a flat rate basis that applies to the first twenty-five (25) campers in the Huddle Hut and the first four (4) campers in the retreat cabin. Additional campers in the Huddle Hut will be charged at the then current Smith Hall rate. Additional campers in the Retreat Cabin are discouraged due to size and safety constraints.
16. The number of cabins available to each User Group depends upon the size and configuration of the Group. There will be an additional charge for additional cabins utilized (in excess of the contracted cabins).
17. Camp Wrightwood is a **Non-Smoking** Camp. 
18. User Groups shall provide staffing in the minimum ratio of 1 person over the age of 18 for every 10 persons under the age of 18—to insure the proper supervision and safety of campers.
19. **CAMP STORE:** Camp Wrightwood operates a camp store with commonly requested items, such as flashlights, water bottles, T- and sweat shirts, hats, batteries, toiletries and limited candy. Personal checks are accepted.
20. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND ILLEGAL DRUGS ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Possession or use of these items by anyone in the group will result in removal from the camp, without refund. *Special permission may be secured for the use of wine for religious purposes.*
21. **RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES:** Swimming, archery, basketball, volleyball, horseshoes, and ping-pong are all available. Necessary equipment will be checked out to Group Leaders upon request.
22. The Camp Swimming Pool is normally available from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend, weather and maintenance permitting. The Camp provides lifeguards at an additional, reimbursement cost.
23. Archery is also normally available from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend, weather and maintenance permitting.
24. During the winter months, **all vehicles must carry tire chains** because of our rapidly changing mountain weather. You may phone us, or visit our online *LIVE CAM* to view current conditions.
