Camp Rulzzz ...

ALCOHOL & SMOKING – Neither are permitted at Camp Wrightwood—nor illegal drugs.

CHILDREN DISCOUNT – The under-10-years-of-age discount applies AFTER the minimum guarantee has been met.

DINING HALL – Coffee and tea are available throughout the day with the purchase of meal service. It is the group's responsibility to send volunteers to the Dining Hall 15 minutes prior to each meal to set-up your group's tables. *It may be necessary to share the Dining Hall with other groups.*

FINAL COUNT SHEET – Your final count sheet must be signed and returned two weeks prior to your arrival. (We prefer mail, but fax is acceptable—760.249.4113). Remember that you will be charged the greater of 1) 90% of the final count, 2) the area minimum guarantee, or 3) the actual number of guests. FINAL COUNT IS CRITICAL TO FOOD SERVICE.

MINIMUM GUARANTEES – Minimum Guarantees and period rates apply to the entire rental period. Please review the terms of your contract regarding these items.

PETS – Please do NOT bring pets to Camp Wrightwood.

SELF-COOKING – If you have chosen self-cooking (Huddle Hut or Smith Hall), bring your own cleaning supplies—detergent, sponges, pot scrubbers, paper towels, cleanser and bleach for sanitizing dishes. Also bring salt-and-pepper, and sugar dispensers or packets.

If you have reserved self-cooking, but have since decided that you would prefer to take advantage of our professional meal service, just phone or e-mail the office and we'll make all the arrangements. *(Note that we need a two-week notice—with final count—to order food).*

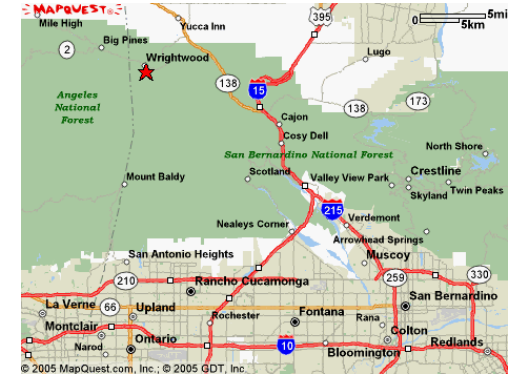
SHARED USE – Camp Wrightwood often hosts multiple groups. While the camp is arranged into three distinct lodging and dining areas, recreational and program areas may need to be shared, and we ask all guests to be considerate and respectful of each other's needs.

5) Turn LEFT onto Elm Street	0.3 miles
6) Elm St Ends AT the Camp Driveway 1401 Linnet Road, Wrightwood, CA 92397
