

Critical Dates & Times ...

We know that your responsibilities as Group Leader can be overwhelming at times; therefore, please know that we have only two critical dates about which you need concern yourself:

- 1) The enclosed **FINAL COUNT SHEET** is **CRITICAL**. It tells us what activities and facilities you want, and how much food to order—**WE MUST RECEIVE YOUR COMPLETED FINAL COUNT SHEET BY «ARRDT14»**.
- 2) **4:00 P.M. CHECK-IN** The Group Leader must check-in upon arrival. Please do not arrive prior to 4:00 p.m.

Communication & Safety ...

FIRST AID Camp Wrightwood does NOT provide health services. Your group must bring a first aid kit and a person who is currently certified in standard First Aid and CPR.

TELEPHONE The Camp Office does NOT accept telephone calls to campers—most cellular phones work in Camp.

AUDIO/VISUAL EQUIPMENT You may reserve the use of a television, VCR/DVD player, overhead projector and screen, easels and dry-erase marker boards—in advance of your arrival. Please bring your own easel pads.

WIRELESS INTERNET We provide FREE Wireless G/B Internet Access. Just request the access key from the Office.

HOUSEKEEPING Our Housekeeping staff visit each facility daily to empty trash and replenish toiletries.

FIREWOOD BRING YOUR OWN FIREWOOD. We will provide firewood for your evening campfire, but our limited supply prevents us from providing it for other uses. Seasonal US Forest Service rules may preclude outdoor wood fires.
